# **Our International priorities**

The Graduate Research Shool, in collaboration with the International Relations Department has developped a strong international strategy including :

You can apply if:

- > You are enrolled in a doctorate program at one of our doctoral schools,

# Mitacs

The Mitacs program is intended for students, doctoral students and post-doctoral fellows wishing to conduct research stays from and to Canada in research laboratories or in industry for a period of 3 to 6 months.
