Funding your project

Eligibility

Each programme is based in accordance with specific criteria, for example:

- › nationality,
- › age,
- › disciplinary field,
- › destination,
- › type of stay (field research, collective project..)

The "International Mobility" IdEx programme at the University of Bordeaux has already supported many doctoral students during their international mobility!

You can apply if:

- › You are enrolled in a doctorate program at one of our doctoral schools,
- › You have the approval of the international research team to welcome you for at least 3 months for a collaborative research project.

Partnerships

The University of Bordeaux has concluded agreements with organisations for providing research grants for students and doctoral candidates at the University of Bordeaux and the University of Bordeaux Montaigne.



The Fulbright-University of Bordeaux program is intended for French doctoral students who wish to visit an American university or research institute for a period of 4 to 12 months.



The Mitacs program is intended for students, doctoral students and post-doctoral fellows wishing to conduct research stays from and to Canada in research laboratories or in industry for a period of 3 to 6 months.
